



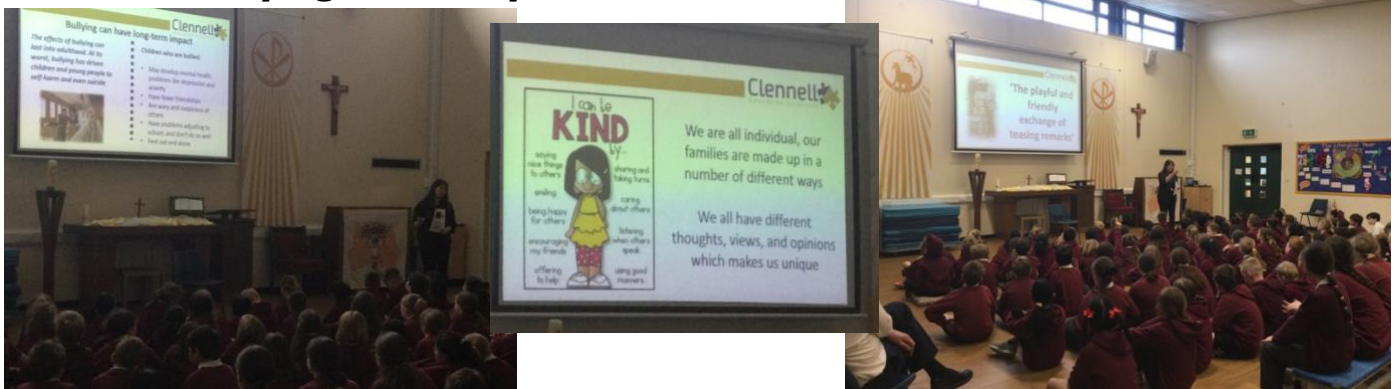

Year 4 Emmaus Village residential

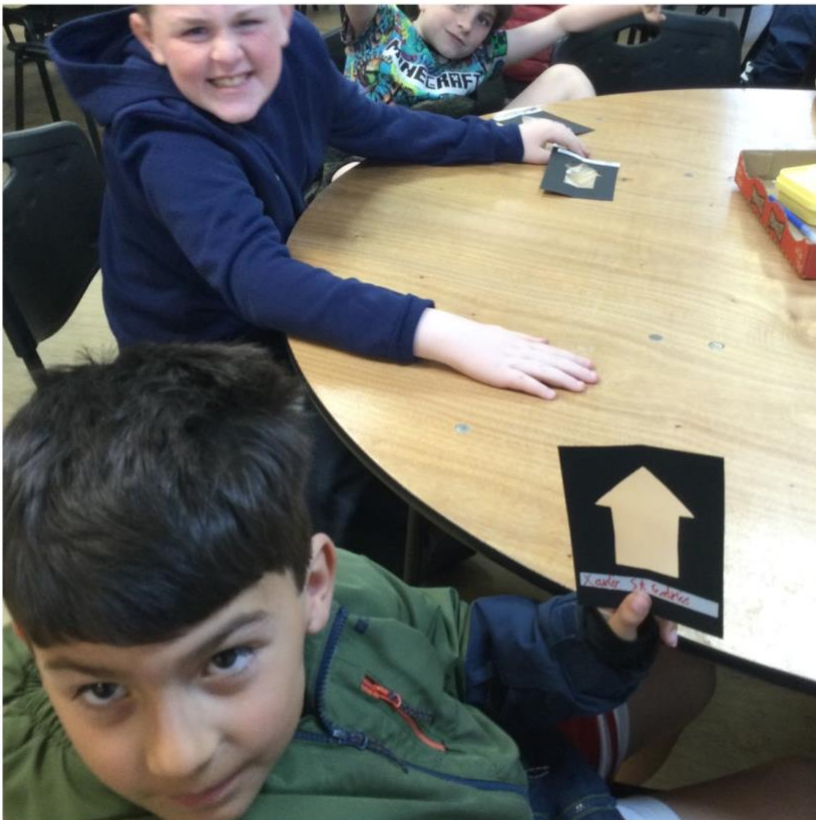
