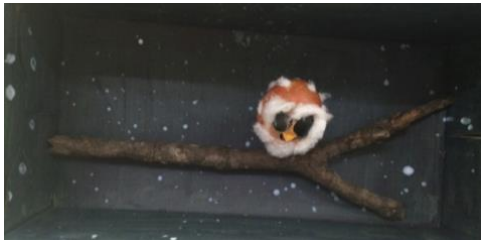
Year 1 trip to Centre for Life

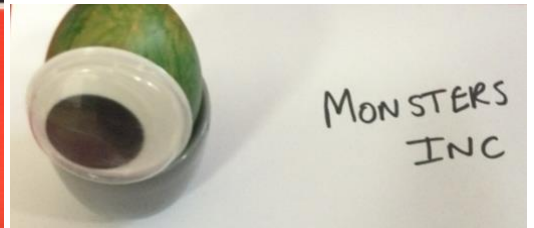




Decorated Egg Competition
