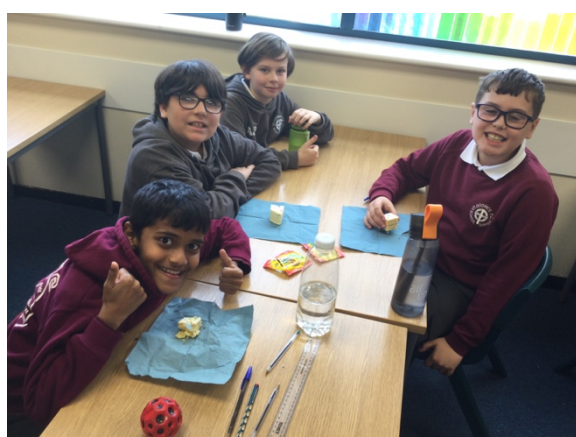
News from this week...

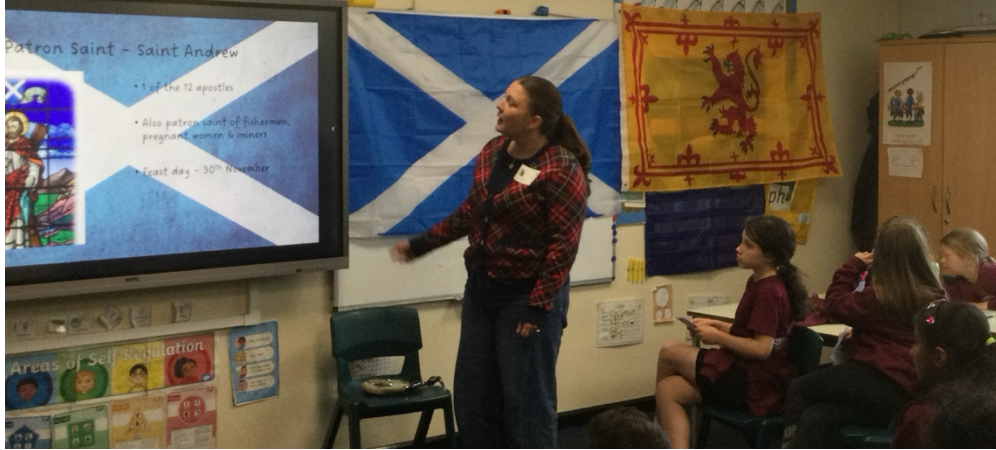




International day event
